Requirements are as followed:

- Parent/Guardian with a child 0 to 3 year's old living in the home or currently pregnant
 **To be eligible for services, participants cannot have an open case with Child Protective Services and cannot have any previously substantiated child abuse and neglect cases.
- Participants must meet the income requirements listed below:
