

## FEDERAL POVERTY GUIDELINES

Income guidelines are revised annually. The following chart displays income levels by household size for the 2018-2019 (July 1, 2018 – March 31, 2019) program year and should be used to determine eligibility. Customers are eligible if their total Household Income is at or below 175% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines.

### HEAP Income Eligibility (175% of Federal Poverty Guidelines)

Households with more than eight members should add \$7,560 to the yearly income or \$630 to the 30-day income for each additional member.

### PIPP Plus Income Eligibility (150% of Federal Poverty Guidelines)

Households with a gross annual Household Income at or below 150% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines are eligible to participate in PIPP Plus. See current income eligibility chart below.

For households with more than eight members, add \$6,480 per member for 12 months or \$540 for 30-day.
