Neighbor to Neighbor Program

The AEP Neighbor to Neighbor Program lends a hand to those who are experiencing financial hardship and need to get back on their feet. Administered by Dollar Energy funds, the program provides eligible customers with a utility assistance grant applied directly to their AEP bill. This grant helps limited-income customers maintain or restore their basic electric service.

Heating Program starts October 3, 2022, through April 28, 2023 for services that are off or in threat of termination.

Balance Requirement:

- Income Guidelines must be at or below 300% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines
- Outstanding balance on their AEP bill of at least \$50.00. Must be behind on bill payment 30 days or more with sincere effort payment, which means applicants must have paid at least \$75.00 on their account in the past three months. Exceptions apply for customers who are Veterans, Active Duty Military or those on Life Support. Maximum Grant amount an applicant may receive is \$500.00
- Account must be residential, single family home or apartment; Name on account must be that of an adult who is living in the home; Funds cannot be used to cover a security deposit or reconnection fees.

Required documents:

- Proof of total household in for past 30 days
- Social Security cards for all household members
- Disconnection Notice or requirement to restore electric services
- Proof of co-payment for reconnect fees (if applicable)
- Electric services must be in adult name who is currently living in the home.
